PROJECT OVERVIEW

John Wearn Reserve is almost complete, with the Contractor focusing on installation of park furniture such as custom picnic shelters, BBQs, drinking fountains and bins. Planting of trees and groundcover plants has commenced, with a total of 100 additional trees and almost 26,000 new plants! As we approach completion please note the site is still an active construction site and is not open to the public.

STAGE CONSTRUCTION

The stage is taking great shape with construction of the floor stage complete, concrete buttresses installed and Wally Friend Amphitheatre (named after a distinguished Rotary Club member) letters cast into the concrete slab. Offsite works are well underway for the fabrication of the bespoke curved roof.

UPCOMING WORKS

Upcoming works include finishing garden bed & tree planting, commencement of fencing installation for the off-leash dog area and continuation of the stage/ amphitheatre.
