## **American Pin Oak**

Originally from North America, this hardy, fast growing, deciduous tree develops into a broad conical shape. Its deep red Autumn foliage makes it an ideal choice when creating vibrant roadside avenues. Growing well in an open, sunny to part-shade position, the Pin Oak is frost, drought and wind tolerant, and once established has a moderate water requirement. You can see a great example of a American Pin Oak planting at 32 Galloway Street, North Parramatta.
