Honey Gem Grevillea

This fast-growing native shrub is the perfect addition to any domestic garden or streetscape. With its large honey-yellow flowers which appear in abundace in Spring, this vibrant shrub will brighten the streetscape. This species is low maintenance and can be pruned and shaped for hedges or low growing bushes or its crown raised and trained into a small tree shape. Enjoying a full-sun to part-shade location, and once established is light frost tolerant and enjoys warm climates.
