## Japanese Zelkova

A great choice for large gardens and park locations, the Japanese Zelkova spreads from a vase shape when young, to a domed broad crown. The deciduous Autumn foliage turns from green to yellow to bright red creating an impressive display before leaves fall in the Winter months. Generally preferring cooler climates, the Japanese Zelkova will adapt to tolerate dry periods once established, but it will be grateful for a little extra attention and deep watering.
