## **Narrow-leaved Apple**

This small tree produces an abundance of flowers late into the Summer months. It provides a splash of colour when most other plants have finished their display, providing nectar for many native insects. Native to coastal woodlands, this hardy tree enjoys a full-sun position making it an excellent street tree. You can see a great example of a Narrowleaved Apple planting at 14 Shelley Street, Winston Hills.
