Outputs — the immediate results of project/program activities and use of inputs, telling us you have done something. E.g Flyers/ website / participants who completed workshop.



Outcomes — the change/s in your participants or community that can be directly attributed to your project. E.g Increase in participant skills/knowledge/confidence; positive change in behaviour and/or life circumstances.
