

Competition Terms and Conditions

General Terms

1. All information on how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions of entry. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. This competition is run by City of Parramatta Council (ABN 49 907 174 773) of 126 Church Street Parramatta NSW 2150 and Suez Recycling & Recovery Pty Ltd (ACN 002 902 650) of Level 3, 3 Rider Boulevard, Rhodes NSW 2138 (**Promoter**).
3. The Promoter reserves the right at any time to disqualify any individual who the Promoter reasonably believes has breached any of the terms and conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper conduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition.
4. The Promoter is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information or for any fault in the equipment utilised in this competition which may result in error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alterations of entries.
5. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entries for which it deems are not suitable or otherwise against the interest of the community.
6. The Promoter may suspend, cancel or vary the competition at any time. The Promoter will not be responsible for any loss incurred by the entrant in relation to such suspension, cancellation or variation.
7. To the extent permitted by the law, the Promoter will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or consequential) to persons or property as a result of any person entering into the competition or accepting or using any prize.
8. By entering this competition, the entrant releases the Promoter (including their agents and affiliates) from, and indemnify the Promoter against all liability, loss, damage or injury arising from or in connection with this competition or prize.

How to Enter

9. To be eligible to enter this competition, the entrant must be a student that attends a school or preschool in the City of Parramatta Local Government Area. To enter the competition, the entrant's parent or legal guardian must submit a short video (< 1min) with the entrant's name, age, class, class teacher name and school name by Private Message to City of Parramatta Facebook, Instagram or Twitter between 1 July 2020 and 25 Sept 2020. Entries close at 5:00pm (AEST) on 25 Sept 2020. No responsibility will be accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries.
11. The entrant must obtain the consent of their parent or legal guardian before entering the competition. By submitting an entry to this competition, the entrant's parent / legal guardian is deemed to have given consent for the entrant to enter this competition. These competition terms and conditions will bind the entrant and the entrant's parent / legal guardian.
12. The video must showcase the entrant's own effort in avoiding, reducing, reusing or recycling soft plastics such as plastic bags, chip packets and cling wrap. It may include footage that shows the direct environmental impact of soft plastic, litter picking, the use of sustainable alternatives, recycling soft plastic in the Redcycle bin or artworks made from soft plastics.
13. The Promoter will select 5 winners from the entries and the winners' entries will be made into a short educational video for the purpose of promoting the avoidance and recycling of soft plastic.
14. The winners must keep the original video and resubmit their entries for publication.

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15. The entry must be the entrant's own original work (Work). By entering the competition, the entrant and the entrant's parent / legal guardian warrants that the Work does not infringe the intellectual property rights of a third party. Entries that infringe intellectual property rights are automatically disqualified from the competition. The entrant and the entrant's parent / legal guardian must indemnify the Promoter against any costs that the Promoter may incur as a result of any intellectual property right infringement.
16. By entering into this competition, the entrant and the entrant's parent / legal guardian grants the Promoter a non-exclusive, fee-free licence to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, edit, publish and communicate the Work to the public.
