

## **Hallowread at Constitution Hill Library Competition Terms and Conditions**

1. The competition is run by City of Parramatta Council (ABN: 49907174773) ("Council") of 126 Church Street. Telephone: 9806 5050.
2. The Competition opens on 19 October 2020 (the "Opening Date"). Entry into the competition closes on 16 November 2020 (the "Closing Date") and entries will be accepted until no later than 4.00pm (AEST) on 16 November 2020.
3. The Competition is open to entrants currently residing in New South Wales only. The Competition is specifically closed to employees of City of Parramatta Council, any associated companies, their agencies and their immediate families and anyone else connected with the creation and administration of the competition.
4. The Competition consists of 5 prizes in total. The prize(s) consist of:
  - 5 x City of Parramatta 'At Parramatta' Gift Cards to the value of \$50Entrants are eligible to win one prize only.
5. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered.
6. To be eligible to enter the competition entrants are required to:
  - Borrow 4 books and make one purchase at Constitution Hill Shopping Village between 19 October 2020 and 4.00pm (AEST), 16 November 2020 inclusive.
  - Submit the hard-copy library and local store receipts as evidence to the Constitution Hill Library collection box in person:

  - Receipts must be originals.
7. By entering the competition, the entrant declares the content submitted to be their own.
8. Entrants aged under 18 years must obtain the consent of their parent or legal guardian to enter the competition and provide personal information about themselves. These Conditions of Entry will bind the entrants and any parent or legal guardian who gives their consent (for entrants aged under 18 years).

9. There is no limit on the number of entries per person but entrants are eligible to win one prize only from the 5 prizes available.
10. No entries shall be accepted before the Opening Date or after the Closing Date. Third party or bulk entries will not be accepted and entries not in accordance with the entry instructions are invalid.

12. Council's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Winners will be contacted by Council staff with further details on how to claim their prize via the phone number provided in the Constitution Hill Library member database on 20 November 2020. If no contact can be made by phone, the Winners shall be contacted by email. All Winners are given two weeks to claim their prize. If the winners do not respond within this time, Council reserves the right to select another winner from the remaining eligible entries.
14. Council will arrange for delivery of the prize to each winner at an agreed Australian address.
15. By entering this Competition, entrants expressly authorise Council, without further consideration, to transmit, reproduce, communicate and broadcast entries on Council's social media channels for the purposes of presenting and promoting the Competition ("Marketing"). Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation.
16. In the event of war, terrorism, state of emergency or disaster, Council reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition or suspend or modify a prize, subject to any written directions from a relevant regulatory authority. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by Council.

17. If this competition is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of Council, including but not limited to technical difficulties, unauthorised intervention or fraud, Council reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the competition, as appropriate.
18. Information regarding personal data provided in the entry will be held and processed in a database for the purpose of managing entry into the competition. The information will not be used for any other purpose than as stated in these Terms & Conditions or as separately accepted by you.
19. Any personal data that is provided will be held and processed in accordance with the requirements of all applicable laws, and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
20. The laws of Australia apply to this competition to the exclusion of any other law. Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Australia.
21. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions. Entry into the competition will thereby be deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions.
22. Subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, Council reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions and/or cancel the Competition at its sole discretion.
