








Calling all children! Let's celebrate Children's Book Week 2020! Better late than never.

Aged 7 to 16? Complete a book review!





Terms & Conditions

- 1. To enter: a 'colouring competition', a 'book review' or a 'my book review' template must be completed and submitted by 31st October. Shortlisted books can be viewed here: https://www.cbca.org.au/shortlist-2020
- 2. The competition opens on Thursday 1 October 2020 and closes on Saturday 31 October 2020. Entries received before or after this date will not be accepted.
- 3. Age group categories are: 2-6 years, 7-11 years and 12-16 years. Entrants must be aged 2-16 during the competition entry period.
- 4. All entrants under the age of eighteen (18) years must have permission of their legal parent or guardian.
- 5. Entries received must be original work. Entries will not be returned and will remain the property of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 6. City of Parramatta Libraries reserves the right to cancel the competition if no suitable entries are found.
- 7. Entries will be judged by staff at City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 8. Entries can be submitted as a hard copy or as a PDF/JPG file and emailed. Entries can be handed in at any City of Parramatta Libraries branch, or emailed to librarycomps@cityofparramatta.nsw.gov.au.
- 9. All entries must be submitted with a completed entry form. Details must be clearly written on the entry page. Multiple children from the same family may enter using the same booklet and one entry form. The name, age and date of birth of each child must be written.
- 10. City of Parramatta Libraries retains the right to alter, use and distribute entries submitted to the competition for a range of promotional and educational purposes, including publication on the website, printed material, social media and generally for the purposes of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 11. Prizes include: $3 \times 50 Dymocks book voucher for the winner of each category, and a book pack to the value of \$30 for the runner up of each category.
- 12. Prizes must be claimed in person from a nominated City of Parramatta Libraries branch. Proof of identity must be supplied.
- 13. If uncollected, or we are unable to contact a winner, after 5 days the prize will be reallocated at the discretion of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 14. Winners will be notified by phone by Monday 23 November 2020.
- 15. Winning entries will be uploaded onto City of Parramatta Libraries social media accounts along with the winner's first name and age.
