## **Bookings & Conditions of Entry**

- A maximum of 100 people will be able to attend at one time. Lane space will be allocated by lifeguards
  according to swimmer ability, mobility and swim school requirements.
- Swim Sessions will be booked for 1 hour (45 minutes swim time, 15 minutes entry/exit).
- Bookings should be made and paid for in advance by calling the centre on 02 9806 5700.
- Bookings are essential and can be made during the opening hours listed above.
- No back to back bookings are permitted.
- Bookings cannot be made for more than 3 days in advance.
- Bookings are to be pre-paid on the phone by credit card, visit pass or 3/6 month membership only. No cash accepted.
- Bookings paying a concession rate will need to present a valid concession/student card on entry to the centre
- There is a strict no refund/credit policy for cancellations or non-attendance once booking and payment have been made.
- Bookings can be made for no more than three consecutive days.
- Customers must exit the pool and facility when instructed by staff. Failure to follow timelines and staff direction may result in permanent removal from the pool and booking system.
- No recreational swimming. Bookings are for lap swimming and swim school only.
- No early entry permitted; gates will remain locked until the session time.
- No public access to changing rooms or showers. Please come ready to swim. Toilets will be available.
- No sunbathing/sitting or gathering on pool deck. Strict "swim and leave" policy.
- Social distancing of 1.5m applies at all times.
- Please do not attend the centre if you have a cough or cold or flu symptoms.
- Please do not attend the centre if you have come into contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days or if directed by health authorities to stay at home.
- Please use hand sanitiser stations provided on entry and exit to centre.
- Cleaning of touch points will occur each hour.
- Deep cleaning and sanitation will occur after the last session of each block.
