



Leading Not for Profit Innovation

In a time of unprecedented change, organisations are under increasing pressure to be nimble and evolve to meet their beneficiary needs and donor expectations. If our organisations are to continue to survive and create new world impact, we need engaged boards and executive teams with the frameworks to enable and drive innovation.

The Leading Innovation Program offers a series of practical workshops to explore how Not for Profit Boards and Executive Teams can better enable purposeful change through developing an innovation mindset and better understanding what 'innovation' might look like in the context of their organisation.

Participation in the program will enable Board and Executive members to::

- increase their confidence in understanding and talking about innovation (and having a shared language around innovation in their organisation);
- be more confident about managing risks and governance best practice for innovation;
- Integrate and prioritise innovation in the strategic planning process;
- foster effective Board and Executive conversations and collaboration around innovation; and
- feel comfortable pushing for innovation/innovative ideas for their organisation.

Who is this for?

It is designed for small teams of Board and Executive team participants from an organisation (2-10 people) with up to 10 organisations participating. The program will be delivered online with video content and worksheets, cohort video conferences, peer support, and team coaching with each organisation.

What does it cost?

The program is being delivered by Dynamic4 and Leading for Purpose, two well-respected design and innovation companies. The cost of the program is \$250 for up to 10 people from a single organisation. What's involved?

The program will start with a kick off session where participants will have the opportunity to network and explore innovation mindsets. Each organisation will then work through 4 self-paced modules and a coaching session, totalling between 4-6 hours of work. The program will then wrap up by bringing organisations back together to share what they learned and how they plan to evolve moving forward.
