Parramatta metro station project update

September 2021

About Sydney Metro West

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Parramatta metro station will support Parramatta CBD as a major employment growth centre, boosting jobs and improving connections across Greater Sydney. It will provide easy, efficient and accessible interchange with buses and Parramatta Light Rail. Parramatta metro station will be on the block bounded by George, Macquarie, Church and Smith streets with an entrance proposed on Horwood Place.

Strategically located to the north of the existing Parramatta Station, the new metro will be within the commercial core of the Parramatta CBD, taking pressure off the existing station and giving customers a second rail option.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

As part of this work Sydney Metro has contracted Delta Group to prepare the site of the future Parramatta metro station.

Site establishment

To prepare for the start of construction, site establishment works will be undertaken over the coming months and include site investigations, surveying, archaeological investigations and service identification. A project site office will be established within the site.

To ensure the safety of the community and workers, hoarding will be installed around the project site prior to works starting to remove existing buildings.

There will be workers in and around the site during this time to prepare the site. Sydney Metro is committed to ensuring the health and safety of workers and the community. Work undertaken will be in line with conditions set by current public health order advice.

Closure of the City Centre Car Park on Horwood Place

In order to facilitate construction of Sydney Metro West, the City Centre Car Park on Horwood Place will close on **30 September 2021**.

We appreciate changes to parking arrangements may cause some inconvenience. There are currently about 3,860 on and off-street parking spaces in the Parramatta Local Government Area. The City of Parramatta operates paid ticket parking in the city centre and North Parramatta.

Nearby alternative off-street parking to the Parramatta city centre is available at:

- Justice Precinct Car Park – Hunter Street
- Parramatta Station Car Park – Wentworth Avenue
- Eat Street Car Park – Erby Street.

Construction hours

Work in and around the Parramatta metro station site will generally be undertaken during construction hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday to Sunday 8am – 6pm.

These hours are dependent on public health order advice and are subject to change.

Work may be required outside of standard construction hours to ensure the safety of workers and the community. Businesses and residents will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work.

Working with other projects

Sydney Metro recognises there are a number of major infrastructure projects underway in Parramatta. These projects will meet the needs of the community now and into the future.

Sydney Metro is working closely with local councils, NSW Government agencies and stakeholders to coordinate construction programs and, where possible, integrate work to minimise impacts on the community. We're doing this by combining project information across agencies to give residents the full picture of what's happening locally and working together to coordinate construction programs and traffic arrangements.
