


Cabbage Tree Palm

Grown for its stately shape and often chosen for its lush tropical effect, the Cabbage Tree Palm adds diversity to the Sydney garden or streetscape. Establishing in 4 to 8 years, this species enjoys a sunny protected position and copes well with wind, drought and fire. Relatively little maintenance is required beyond the occasional watering and removal of dry fronds.
