

# Ornamental Pear

The Ornamental Pear is naturally found in woodlands or on rocky hillside thickets in China and Japan but has adapted to and thrives in the Australian climate.

The Ornamental Pear is known for its small, white, fragrant flowers that bloom in autumn, providing a contrast to the prevalence of Australian natives. It is established within 3-5 years of planting and is tolerant of most weather conditions.
