
Outcome Indicators

Outcome Indicators set the benchmark figures for measuring the success of your project. Indicators need to be specific, measurable and realistic. They will link directly to each Outcome Statement. Indicators help you to identify what data needs to be collected in order to measure and evaluate project outcomes.



Examples - We will know if we are successful if...



100% of participants know how to use at least one new manual tool and one new motorised tool following completion of the 6-week program, 29 May 2022



95% of participants demonstrate an increase in skills for performing basic home maintenance following completion of the 6-week program, 29 May 2022



90% of participants report an increase in confidence with using tools and attempting basic home maintenance following completion of the 6 week program, 29 May 2022



85% of participants will attempt basic home maintenance in the 3 months following the 6 week program.... (and 70% report being successful).
