## Public domain condition

This local centre interfaces with the future Light Rail Station, with a signalised crossing facilitating pedestrian movement into the centre. No on-street parking is evident, largely due to the limited width of the Adderton Road frontage with a single lane of traffic for vehicular movement in each direction. The public domain extends more generously to the north, with mature canopy cover and a raised garden bed offering visual relief.

### **Demographics**

- ▶ Between 2016 and 2020 Telopea experienced a 10% increase in population, from 5,439 to 6,008.
- ▶ In 2021, the largest age group (23%) is forecast to be parents and homebuilders (35 to 49 year olds).
- ▶ The largest increase between 2016 and 2021 is forecast to be couple families with dependents, which will increase by 63 households and account for 33.4% of all households.
