This information will tell you about all the things you can do and see.

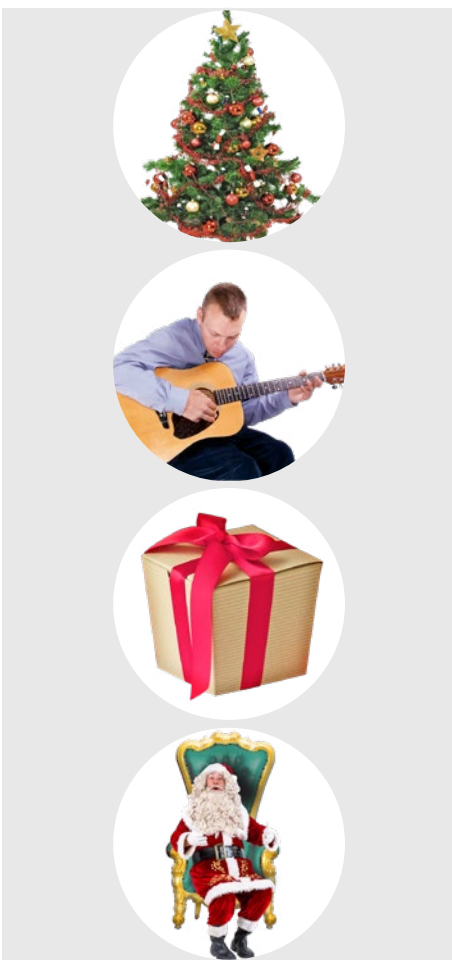

- Photos with Santa.



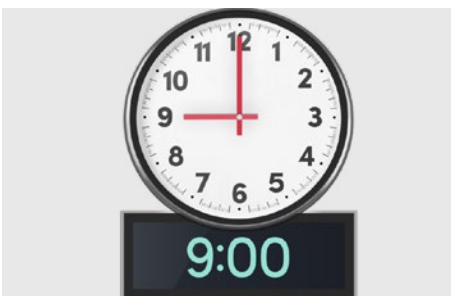
We will have Christmas markets on

- Lacrosse.

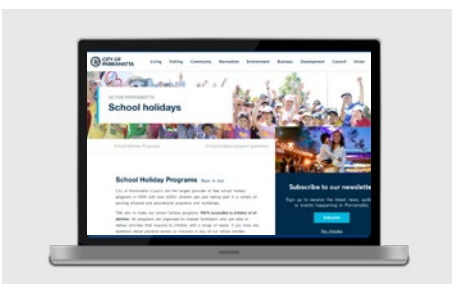


There will also be fun things for kids to do at our libraries.

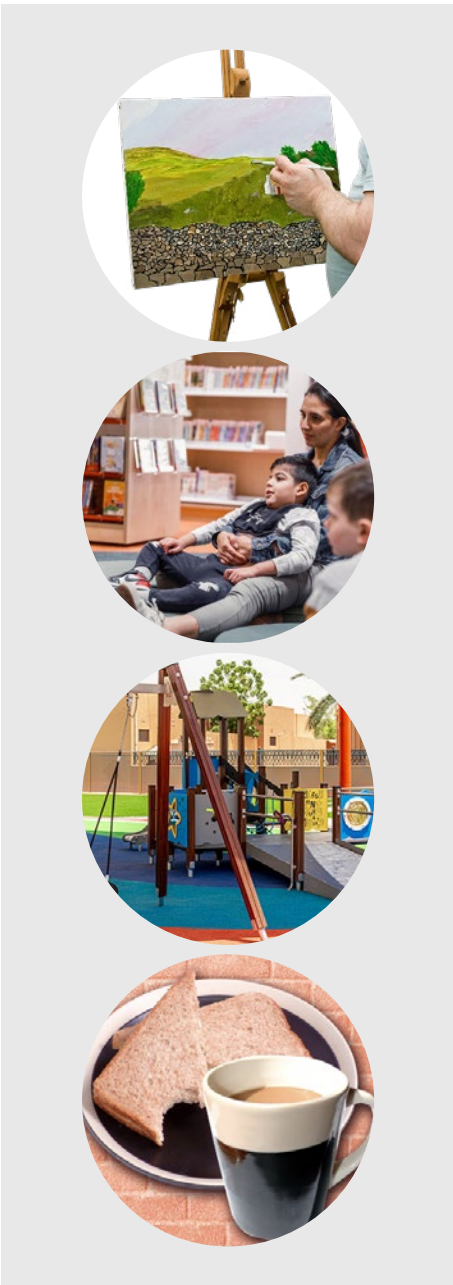

Sydney Festival

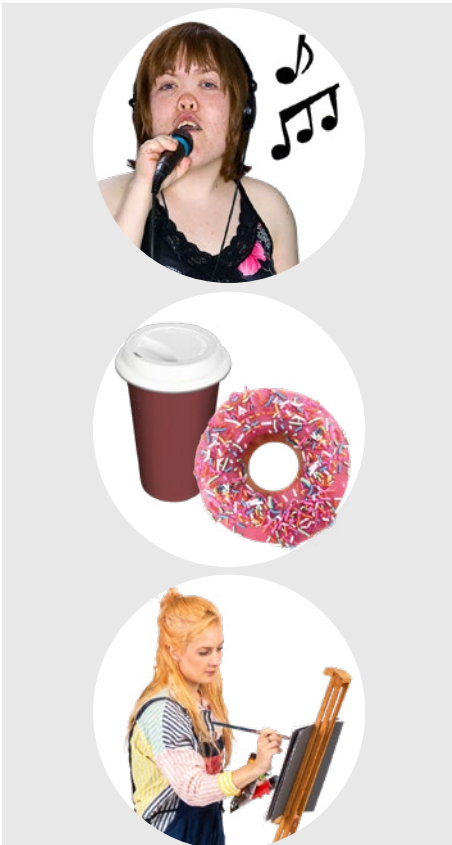


We will have some fun events for Sydney Festival.

It will end on Sunday 29 January 2023.



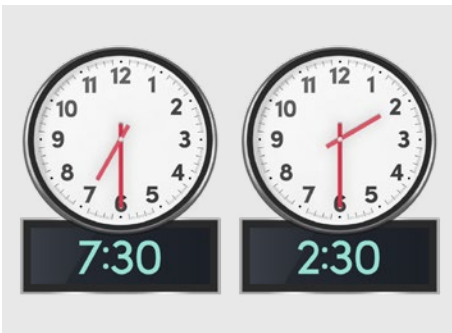

It is the Year of the Rabbit.



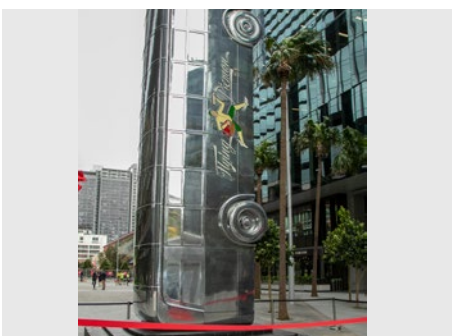
Lunar New Year is the time the Asian community celebrate the new year.

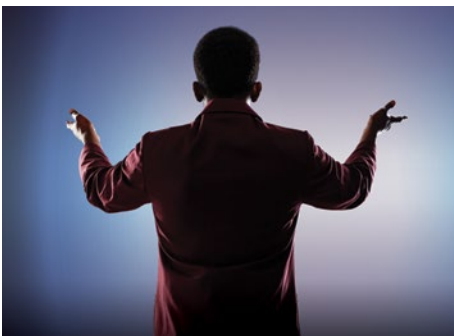
