Beat the summer slump by participating in our summer reading program. Participant on your own, or with your family to win one of 6 major prizes worth \$100.


Keen to enter on your own? Fill in the page(s) that are relevant to your age group. Make sure you get a parent/guardian to help fill out the entry form, if you're under 18.

GUESS WHAT? AGES 13 +


Guess the titles of some popular adult & young adult fiction novels by solving these rebus puzzles.





Terms & Conditions

- 1. To enter: a 'Summer Reading Program' booklet must have a minimum of one age relevant section completed and submitted by 31 January 2023.
- 2. The competition opens on Thursday 1 December 2022 and closes midnight on Tuesday 31 January 2023. Entries received before or after this date will not be accepted.
- 3. Entrants must complete an age relevant section during the competition entry period.
- 4. All entrants under the age of eighteen (18) years must have permission of their legal parent or guardian.
- 5. Entries received must be original work. Entries will not be returned and will remain the property of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 6. City of Parramatta Libraries reserves the right to cancel the competition if no suitable entries are found.
- 7. Entries will be judged by staff at City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 8. Entries can be submitted as a hard copy or as a PDF/JPG file and emailed. Entries can be handed in at any City of Parramatta Libraries branch, or emailed to librarycomps@cityofparramatta.nsw.gov.au
- 9. All entries must be submitted with a completed entry form. Details must be clearly written on the entry page.
- 10. City of Parramatta Libraries retains the right to alter, use and distribute entries submitted to the competition for a range of promotional and educational purposes, including publication on the website, printed material, social media and generally for the purposes of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 11. City of Parramatta Libraries will retain entries and entry forms for a period of 3 months from the competition close date before securely destroying them.
- 12. Major prize includes: 8 x \$100 gift cards.
- 13. Prizes must be claimed in person from a nominated City of Parramatta Libraries branch. Proof of identity must be supplied.
- 14. If uncollected, or we are unable to contact a winner, after 5 days the prize will be reallocated at the discretion of City of Parramatta Libraries.
- 15. Winners will be notified by phone by Monday 13 February 2023.
- 16. Winning entries may be uploaded onto City of Parramatta Libraries social media accounts along with the winner's first name and age.
