PARRAMATTA AQUATIC CENTRE (PAC) HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTRE

PARRAMATTA LIGHT RAIL TREE PLANTING GREENING OUR PARKS

The City of Parramatta and Transport for NSW jointly planted 210 trees in our City's parks and reserves throughout November as part of the Parramatta Light Rail tree planting program. An additional 2,190 trees will be added to our streets and parks over the next two years.



NEW URBAN SPACE

JUNCTION STREET PLAZA, GRANVILLE

City of Parramatta Council and NSW Government are planning an urban park for the space under the M4 in Granville. This adventurous project will commence in 2024. We are looking for input from the community, particularly young people 11 to 15 years old, to help transform the space into something safe and social with a great vibe.
