### WINTER AT RIVERSIDE THEATRES

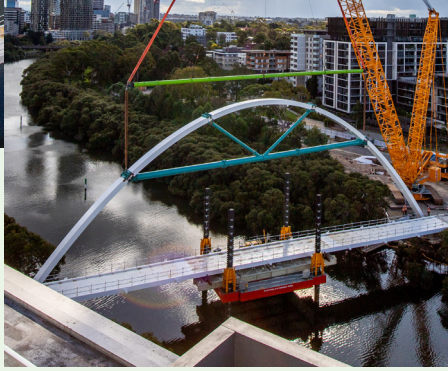

## NEW PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLIST BRIDGE

Opening this winter is the new Alfred Street Bridge, a pedestrian and cyclist bridge over the Parramatta River between James Ruse Drive and the Gasworks Bridge. 'Alfie' will be Australia's first true diagonal arch bridge, and will connect to the future Tramway Avenue light rail stop, located south of the bridge.

# UPGRADES IN YOUR AREA



## PARRAMATTA WARD

### Completed upgrades

- > Playground, half-court basketball, bouldering wall, nature play, BBQ, water fountain, fitness stations and lighting installed at Arthur Phillip Park.
- > Creative lighting installed in Phillip Lane for future laneway activations.

### Planned upgrades

- >> Milson Park Masterplan - includes new wetlands to increase habitat diversity, pedestrian and cycle shared path, nature play, BBQ and picnic areas and fitness stations.



## NORTH ROCKS WARD

### Completed upgrades

- > Barnett Dog Park has been improved with two seats, shelters, updated signage, plants and mulching.

### Planned upgrades

- >> Third Settlement Reserve - upgrade of fitness equipment.
- >> Max Ruddock Reserve amenities building upgrade through WestInvest funding.
- >> Don Moore pathway and furniture upgrade.



## DUNDAS WARD

### Completed upgrades

- > New granite paving, disabled parking, bench seating, trees and plants, pedestrian paths, outdoor dining areas, and accessible kerbs ramps installed at Gibbons Street shops.

### Planned upgrades

- >> Stamford Avenue Shops upgrade to improve accessibility.
- >> New picnic area, trees, bike rack, rubber flooring, play equipment, swings, and benches for Anna Maria King Playground.



## EPPING WARD

### Planned upgrades

- >> New mural project at Epping Library.
- >> Epping Town Centre East upgrade to improve intersection accessibility, with new trees and plants.



## ROSEHILL WARD

### Completed upgrades

- > Recently upgraded Good and Bridge streetscapes, with new seating and outdoor dining areas.
- > Rydalmere Field 1 and 2 upgrades are underway and expected to open to the public later this year.

### Planned upgrades

- >> Upgrading the connection between Granville Town Centre, FS Garside and M4 Cycleway with accessible kerbs and wider footpaths, and increased shade.
