PARRAMATTA LIGHT RAIL IS NOW BEING TESTED

Light rail testing is underway to make sure the systems and vehicles are safe. Road conditions have changed, and trams can't stop quickly or easily.

EPHING AQUATIC CENTRE UPGRADES

The Epping Aquatic Centre will close for construction from 30 April 2024. This includes upgrading the outdoor 50m pool, new 20m indoor pool and upgrades to the existing family waterplay area. A much-loved community asset, it will remain in its current bushland setting and include key upgrades that will benefit the community, now and into the future.



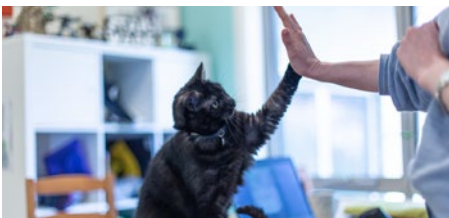
IMPORTANT TRAFFIC CHANGES ON NORTH ROCKS ROAD

Construction will start soon on the Hunts Creek Bridge, with major works to North Rocks Road adjacent to the Woolworths carpark. There will be some unavoidable traffic disruptions, including North Rocks Road becoming one-way for five months, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents.

WEST EPHING PARK DOG OFF-LEASH AREA

Council is currently in process of finalising administrative requirements to deliver the West Epping Park dog off-leash area. The \$354,000 project is being funded by the NSW Government's Western Sydney Infrastructure Grants Program. It is anticipated that all requirements will be completed in early-mid 2024 with construction to commence soon after.

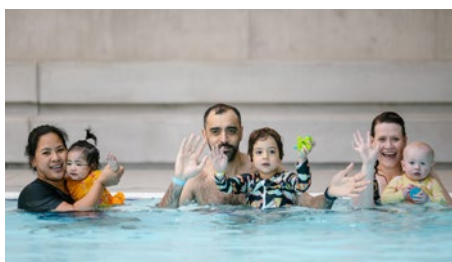

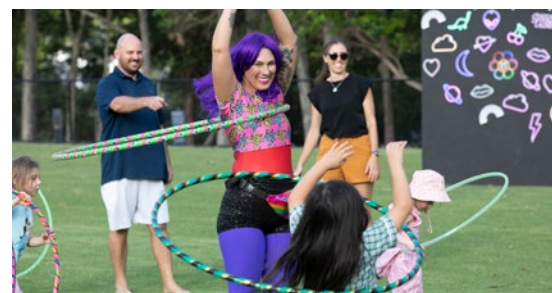


ACTIVE PARRAMATTA AWAITS
