City of Parramatta Truck Art Competition 2025

Calling all kids attending a Primary School in the Parramatta LGA! The popular Truck Art Competition is back again with high demand. We are seeking great designs from our young residents about understanding the new bin service FOGO (Food Organics and Garden Organics).

What is the challenge?

This year's challenge is about educating people about the correct way to sort your waste with the new FOGO service. When the incorrect things are placed into the FOGO bin it contaminates and ruins all the pure organics making it a longer and harder process to create compost, fertiliser etc as they will need to be physically removed from the FOGO bins. The purpose of sorting your FOGO waste correctly is firstly to repurpose our food and garden waste and secondly to eliminate food waste being sent to landfill as we are running out of space.

Students are asked to apply their creativity and artistic skill and colour in the provided artwork in a visually stunning way or design their own masterpiece on the provided A4 paper which brings the community's attention to sort their FOGO waste correctly with the slogan **"Anything you can Eat or Grow, Feed it to FOGO".**

Prizes

The overall winning student (1) artwork will appear on the side of a FOGO collection truck and receive a \$200 gift card.

The best seven (7) entries from each year group (Kindergarten to Year 6) will each receive (1) family movie combo gift card (2 adults & 2 children) to Event cinemas valued at \$100.

The school of the overall winning student (1) will have the opportunity to choose either a sports pack or an environmental pack valued up to \$1000.

How long is this competition?

This competition opens on 11th August 2025 and closes on 19th of September 2025.

Winners will be notified via telephone or email in October 2025 and invited to attend the Truck Art awards ceremony in November 2025 to the unveiling of the overall winning artwork on the truck and receive their certificates and prizes..

How to enter the competition?

To enter the competition, simply use the colouring-in sheet provided or create your own FOGO themed artwork on the provided A4 paper with the competition entry form and hand it to the class teacher.
