## **GETTING TO PHIVE**

PHIVE is located in Parramatta Square, next to Parramatta Town Hall.

Approximately 200 metres from Parramatta Train Station.

# **ENTERING PHIVE**

### When you arrive at PHIVE, you will:



PHIVE GROUND FLOOR FOYER

Enter through the large glass doors from Parramatta Square.

The glass doors bring you into PHIVE's ground floor foyer. This is a large community space where people meet, play games, and often have lunch together.

There is a customer service desk at the ground floor foyer as you enter. Feel free to speak to our friendly team and ask any questions you may have.

If you would prefer to take the stairs and not the lift, the stairs are located to the right of the lift area behind the glass doors.

Take the lift from the foyer down to **B1**, where the Discovery Space is located.

Toilets, including accessible, are located to your left as you exit the lift. Please note, there are no toilets inside the Space Play projection space.

Our friendly staff, easily identifiable by their **red** PHIVE lanyard, will scan your ticket.

They're here to help with tickets, directions and session times or can show you to a welcoming space if you need some quiet time.


Please have your ticket ready to show our staff on arrival.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

**Space Play** is a large, interactive installation that surrounds you with light, movement, and sound. Projections appear on large walls, wrapping around the space to create an immersive galaxy experience filled with stars, comets, asteroids, and planets.

As you move through the room—waving your arms, walking, or gently running—the space will respond. Asteroids may swirl around you, stars may form above, and planets can shift across the galaxy. It's a chance to feel like you're flying through space!



**INSTALLATION** 

The first scenes of the installation include large-scale projections and movement that may cause **dizziness or visual discomfort** for some people who are sensitive to light and motion. The room is dark, and the immersive environment can be highly stimulating at times.

If you ever feel the need to pause, there is seating available in the amphitheatre. You are also welcome to step out to our breakout space, where you can re-enter the installation at your own pace.

The installation will be played twice to allow for people to experience the wonderful galactical universe at their own pace.



INSTALLATION

There will be **families moving and playing** freely throughout the session, which can sometimes feel a little energetic.

Our friendly staff are there to support you and ensure that the environment remains safe and comfortable for everyone.

Please take your time and enjoy the experience in a way that feels best for you.

Food and hot beverages are not permitted in the venue.

There are **no toilets inside the ticketed Space Play area**, but don't worry, you're welcome to leave and return at any time.

Just speak to our staff at the entrance and we'll provide you with a reentry stamp.

Toilets are located **just outside the venue**, next to the lifts on the same level as the Space Play installation.

Please speak to our staff if you need directions or assistance.

# **AFTER YOUR SESSION**
