



KEEPING OF SHEEP & GOATS

- 1.1** The keeping of sheep and goats on residential premises in the Parramatta LGA is not recommended, due to the high potential for nuisance and disturbance to neighbouring residents.
- 1.2** Council may allow for a maximum of one (1) sheep or goat to be kept on a residential premises subject to the submission and approval of a Plan of Management, detailing how nuisances from noise, odour and pests will be managed.
- 1.3** Sheep and goats must be kept in an enclosed yard to prevent their escape. The yard must be **located so that it is at least 6m from any residential dwelling, school, child care centre or boundary.**



1.4 Sheep and goats may only be kept on property where suitable grazing exists. The animals are not permitted to be grazed on public reserves or nature strips.

1.5 Animals are not to be slaughtered at a residential premises under any circumstances.
