

Dolphins Swim School COVID-19 Terms & Conditions

We ask that you follow the direction of staff at all times during your visit. Abusive and/or failure to follow staff direction will result in you being asked to leave the centre. Police will be called if required.

- All patrons aged 12 years and over attending the centre for Dolphins Swim School classes **must be fully vaccinated** against COVID-19.
- Fully vaccinated means having received two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine approved for use in Australia by the TGA, and two weeks have elapsed since the second dose.
- Staff will be checking vaccination status of all Swim School students 12 years and over upon entering the centre. Accepted COVID-19 Vaccination evidence must be on a mobile device using the Medicare Plus APP or official print out of Australian Vaccination Health Transcript or Services Australia My Health Record. Patrons that have a Medical Exemption will need to arrange a medical contraindication; please refer to the "Acceptable Proof of COVID Vaccination and Exemption" tab on this webpage.
- "Practice Lane" at MGHS Pool to be available to Octopus levels and higher when lane space permits. The Duty Manager's will allocate accordingly. You must supervise your child if using this lane.
- Social distancing of 2sqm per person in indoor & outdoors areas is encouraged.
- Please do not enter the centre for your lesson if you or your child have a cough or cold or flu symptoms.
- Students/families that arrive for lessons unwell will be asked to leave the centre immediately
- Please use hand sanitiser stations provided on entry and exit to centre.
- Deep cleaning and sanitation will occur after the last lesson each day.

NOTE: These Terms and Conditions are in addition to the regular Terms and Conditions for Dolphins Swim School and should be read in conjunction.
